


## Family Challenge Week 4 (8<sup>th</sup> – 13<sup>th</sup> March)

# challenge

*These are the instructions Jesus gave his disciples when he sent them out to share in his work. Jesus' friends were being asked to make sure people knew God's love had been very close to them. That was much more important than finding the best place to eat. Sometimes we fuss about little things instead of getting on and doing the really important things.*
